AUF DER WAAGSCHALE

RABBI SHLOMO KAHN

In Verbindung mit der Ueberlieferung, dass an den Jomim Noroim G'tt uns richtet und zwar unsere Mitzwos und unsere Aweros, die wir waehrend des Jahres begangen haben, "auf die Waagschale" gelegt werden, wird folgende chassidische Legende erzaehlt:

Ein armes juedisches Ehepaar fuhr mit Pferd und Wagen am Erew Pessach von der Stadt zurueck ins Dorf mit den bescheidenen Pessachwaren die sie sich leisten konnten. Es war schon spaet nachmittag und sie hatten Malheur, der Wagen blieb im Schlamm stecken. Mann und Frau versuchten, dem Pferd zu helfen, sanken aber selber bis zu den Knieen in den Schlamm.

Da kam ein vornehmer Wagen mit Doppelgespann vorbei und dessen Insasse, ein reicher Gutsbesitzer, liess halten, half der armen Familie weiter zu fahren und gab ihnen auch noch eine schoene Geldspende zu Ehren Pessachs mit.

Kurz nach Pessach starb dieser reiche Mann. Er war selbst auch Jude, war aber abtruennig geworden und hielt nichts mehr von den juedischen Gesetzen. Als seine Seele vor G'tt erschien, wurden schon seine Aweros auf die eine der beiden Waagschalen gehaeuft. Diese schienen gar kein Ende zu nehmen und unter

der schweren Last senkte sich die Schale tief zu Boden.

Da kam ein kleiner, blasser Engel und legte auf die andere Waagschale die einzige gefuelte Mitzwo des Verstorbenen, naehmlich die gute Tat am Erew Pessach.

Es war eine schoene, hell glaenzende und gut duftende Mitzwo, aber war viel zu klein gegenueber der Aweros. Schon war das himmlische Gericht bereit, die Seele zu verurteilen, da aber verlangte der Verteidiger, auch das Paket Matzos und Pessach-Waren mit hineinzulegen. Aber immer noch blieb die Schale zu leicht.

"Bringt Pferd und Wagen!" befahl der Engel, jedoch selbst dadurch ruerhte sich nicht die mit Aweros gefuelte Schale vom Ort. Da hiess der Engel den ganzen Schlamm bringen, in dem der Wagen stecken blieb und so lange schuettete man Schlamm in die Schale der Mitzwo, bis sie erschwert zu Boden sank und der Verstorbene wurde frei gesprochen.

G'ttes Liebe, so lehrt uns diese Erzaehlung, nimmt alles mit in Betracht, selbst die Schwierigkeiten, die sich uns manchmal bei der Erfuellung unserer Pflicht in den Weg stellen. Sie sollen uns aber nicht zurueckschrecken, denn, so sprechen unsere Weisen in Pirke Owos: *לפום צערא אגרא* entsprechend der Muehe ist der Lohn."

QUESTION: The 9th blessing of the Sh'mone Esre begins: "Bless for us, G-d, our G-d, this year..." Once a year this prayer for Parnoso seems out of place. At Mincho-time on Erev Rosh ha-Shono the year is almost over, a few more minutes and the new year will be ushered in. Does it make sense to pray at that time: "Bless for us this year?"

ANSWER: How often does an entire future hinge on a fleeting moment of time. A careless word, a thoughtless action, an unfortunate accident can quickly destroy life or fortune. And conversely, a life of happiness can at times be the result of a moment's event. Thus, even for the last few minutes we pray for G-d's blessing for the outgoing year.

QUESTION: The 6th blessing of the Sh'mone Esre begins: "Forgive us, our Father, for we have sinned..." Once a year this prayer for forgiveness seems out of place. At Maariv-time after Yom Kippur is over and we have been forgiven our sins, does it make sense to pray, just a few minutes after N'iloh, "Forgive us, our Father?"

ANSWER: With tongue in cheek, our people answer this question by pointing to the manner in which Maariv services are conducted after the end of N'iloh. Surely we need forgiveness for such a Maariv! But seriously (although this unfortunate situation is all too common) there are sins which Yom Kippur does not atone. Wherever true T'shuvo is lacking, the sin is not forgiven. Transgressions against fellow-man without first attaining the wronged person's pardon, are not forgiven. Therefore, even at Yom Kippur's end, we continue to pray and hope for forgiveness.

Fuerstenthal, somewhat subdued by this outburst, continued to listen attentively as Orlowsky spoke :

"If I encounter serious anxiety in providing for myself and my family and sometimes find myself incapable of coping with my problems, then I turn to our Holy Writings and seek comfort there. This I have always found. Just today, this morning, I chanced upon the verse in the Psalms of David : 'Cast your burden upon G-d and He will sustain you.' I was reminded of an explanation given by the famous Maggid of Dubno which I heard when I was young. The thought of this verse and its explanation already banished at once all worry and I involuntarily smiled so that my wife wanted to know why. When I told her, she too was similarly cheered and satisfied."

Fuerstenthal now begged Orlowsky to reveal this explanation and Orlowsky began :

"The Maggid of Dubno was a famous man. Here he is not well known but from where I come, he continues to be very much alive although he died long ago. His uniqueness consisted of the ability to explain even the most difficult Bible passages by means of excellent parables. Here, the verse of the Psalms compares worry with a load, a burden, which we should cast upon G-d. The Maggid illustrated this with the following parable :

"A simple-minded traveller was on the road on a hot day, wearily lugging two heavy valises. When a horse-drawn wagon began to overtake him, he hailed the driver and begged him for a ride. The driver cheerfully agreed and the traveller climbed in and seated himself behind the driver. About half an hour

later, the driver noticed that his passenger was still holding the heavy valises in his hand. When he asked about it, the traveller answered shyly :

"It is enough that you permit me to ride with you. I cannot expect you to transport my heavy load in addition."

Laughing heartily, the driver said : "Just put your load down. I am transporting it anyway, even if you hold on to it!"

This foolishness of the traveller, so comments the Maggid of Dubno, over which we tend to smile, actually exists among those that laugh over it more than they imagine. Everybody has his load of worries with which he is burdened as he travels through life. G-d, Who has given us life, also gives us the means to live it. Therefore we read in the Psalms : 'Cast your burden upon G-d, He must anyway sustain you.'

Fuerstenthal, now convinced that Orlowsky will remain steadfast, finished his tea and was ready to call it a day. Orlowsky however, expected some comment and when it was not forthcoming, he asked :

"Well, was this not a nice explanation ?"

"Nice it is," Fuerstenthal said, "but that is not the point here at all. I will go a step further and admit that it is much nicer to rest on Shabbos than to work. But what is nice is not always good and right. Good and right it is to utilize one's time and not to spend such a large part of it in idleness and rest."

Orlowsky refused to be deterred, not even when Fuerstenthal impatiently glanced at his watch and gave other obvious

signs that he would have liked to end the conversation. Orlowsky continued:

"If you are not thoroughly convinced of the fact that G-d, Who provides for every human soul, has sanctified and blessed the seventh day, then I understand your behavior although I cannot condone it. What I beg of you is nothing more than that you too give justification for my point of view and refrain from tempting me to forsake it. It would not help much to do so anyway. Every conscientious Jew is deeply and reverently attached to his G-d-given Shabbos. But aside from that, I once underwent an experience in this respect, which cannot easily be forgotten. If you permit me, I shall tell you the following true story."

Did the wealthy and prominent Mr. Fuerstenthal get a glimpse of the great gulf that separated him, with all his wealth, education and enlightenment from the indestructable idealism of the poor, lowly clothing dealer? Or did he only out of politeness agree to listen to the story? At any rate, he begged Mr. Orlowsky to tell his experience.

"I come from a small Russian village. The entire village belonged to a wealthy nobleman, Count Ashinsky, a man who was feared by the people in his region for his spiteful malice. He treated the peasants, who were his serfs, very cruelly and he was even more inhumanly brutal towards Jews. He had unlimited power over life and death in the entire region. The slightest theft or even the smallest infringement of his harsh orders was punished by death. In his castle's court yard stood a gallows on which at least once a month an unfortunate person was hanged in the presence of all inhabitants.


When this scoundrel learned that the dearest possessions of his Jewish serfs were the synagogue and the Beth Hamidrash (study hall), he had the synagogue demolished and the study hall converted into a stable for his animals. In short, there was no brutality of which this barbarian was not capable and which he did not maliciously commit. There was no judge on earth before whom he could be summoned.

Feudal labor on the property of Count Ashinsky was the lot of the peasants. On Shabbos Jews were, as a matter-of-fact, excused from work in the same way as the others were off on Sunday. In spite of all lack of freedom and rights, in spite of all the violations that the Jews had to bear, no ruler and no lord in the Russian Empire ever dreamed of taking from them the Jewish Shabbos.

Then, one day, the shocking news came, Count Ashinsky requested the Jews to work on Shabbos! He knew fully well that the Jews would try to disobey such an order. Therefore he added that any Jew who refuses to work on the day on which he was assigned, would immediately be hanged. Furthermore he ordered that the rabbi of the community, who had always been exempted from field labor, must report personally for work on the following Shabbos.

I was at that time a boy of ten years but the agitation of those days are so fresh in my memory as if all that had occurred only yesterday. Such an experience is unforgettable. The community gathered for counsel, the rabbi decreed fasting and prayers. The cries and lamentations of the unfortunate community rose to heaven day and night.


