

To the 'Atlantic'.

(Editor's Note: Following is a condensation of a letter written in answer to the controversial article, "I Married a Jew," which appeared in the January issue of the "Atlantic Monthly." The letter in full appears in the March issue) Dear Atlantic:

The article "I Married A Jew" represents a particularly vicious type of propaganda. It purports to portray the characteristics of Jews by one who is motivated by the best of intentionsone who is happily married to a Jew. It is doubly pernicious owing to the the subject). fact that the author is unknown, and therefore cannot be exposed as a Nazi propaganda agent-her identity all too apparently from the misrepresentations and misstatements embodied in the article.

In view of the false statements contained therein, it is not a little surprising that a magazine of the Atlantic Monthly's calibre and standing would publish such an article, whose author hides behind the cloak of anonymity. Permit us to suggest that we consider such a proceeding decidedly un-American.

The Jew who hankers to return to the land from which he emigrated is as scarce as hen's teeth. It is sad, but only too true, that Jews who come to America leave behind them nothing to inspire in them a yearning to return.

Statements to the effect that Jews are first Jews and then Americans, and that they stay only as long as all goes well, are deliberate and unprovoked fabrications unsupported by the facts.

How many Jews do you know who have left America to reside on foreign shores? We cannot name one. The author says that Jews must "make up their minds whether they want to be primarily citizens of, say, France or England, or primarily citizens of Jewry.

Pray tell us what rights and privileges accrue to one who is a citizen of 'Jewry' The idea is ludicrous. The truth of the matter is that Jews are among the most American of Americans, just as they are among the most English of Englishmen. Examine the statistics on the number of Jews who fought in the World War in the various armies, and then judge whether they are patriotic.

It is exfremely regrettable that the Atlantic Monthly saw fit to publish such an unfair and biased dissertation on a subject which can be the root of much unjustifiable prejudice.

The fact that the husband of the lady in question never read the New Testament does not warrant the conclusion that no Jews have ever read it. His alleged pride in his non-Jewish appearance and surname should not be insinuated as a characteristic of Jews in general. It moves us to scorn, and then to pity.

Perhaps the best barometer of the significance of Jewish contributions to the musical literature of the world is to be found in the long catalogue of compositions which are banned in Nazi Germany today. The music of Mendelssohn, Mahler, Goldmark, Wieniawski, and Saint-Saens alone, when removed from concert-programs, can create a cultural gap of no mean proportions.

Yet a further examination of the role which Jews have played in the field of music will discover that from the nineteenth century through the present day Jews have been among the outstanding genii both in the composition and interpretation of musical works of art.

Many Jewish Composers

Scores of composers of Jewish birth might be named. But even to those not versed in musical lore the following names of Jewish composers would be familiar.

Maurice Ravel, popularly known for his "Bolero"; George Bizet, best known for the opera "Carmen"; Jacques Offenbach, the creator of "Tales of Hoffman." Light Operettists

In light opera, that combination of pure melody and lyricism, Jews have been among the foremost of the composers in the field. Rudolf Friml, ("The Vagabond King"), Emerich Kalman ("Countess Maritza"), Sigmund Romberg ("The Chocolate Soldier"), are the best-loved and best-known Jewish composers.

The number of Jews engaged in writng popular music, of the jazz variety, is almost limitless. Even in this section of musical creativity Jews are among the leaders in the field. It is of interest to note, for example, that the music for "Knickerbocker Holiday," the Playwrights' Company current musical hit, was written by Kurt Weill, a Jew.

Music-The Universal Tongue

These are only a few of the bright stars in a galaxy of Jewish creative talent. Discussion of living composers of concert music alone would require far greater space. But it is hoped that the simple reference to the aforementioned men will open to the mind of the reader the realization that Jews have stood among the great in this most universal of all arts.
