## PINKAS

The word that heads this article is not generally known. It is the Hebrew for Record or Chronical. In the old Jewish communities of Eastern and Central Europe a Pinkas used to be kept faithfully and meticulously. In our day these chronicals are mines of Jewish history out of which useful information of the life of our people may be drawn.

Our congregation is now establishing such a Pinkas. We call it the Family Record of a Member. We seek to preserve through that record useful dates, important anniversaries and significant events in the lives of our members and their families. A questionnaire has recently been sent out to our membership and the information called for in that questionnaire will be included in the family record that we intend to keep of each member.

The questionnaires properly filled out are coming back to us day by day. Approximately 25% have already been received. We are anxious to have them all and to have them as speedily as possible. If anyone experiences any difficulty whatever in filling out the questionnaire Mr. Adler, our Ritual Director, will be glad to offer his assistance. Please therefore, attend to this important matter without delay.
