CHIEF RABBI OF IRELAND TO PREACH AT SABBATH SERVICES MARCH 2nd

Rabbi Immanuel Jakobovits, Chief Rabbi of Ireland will be the guest of the Synagogue on Saturday, March 2nd. He will preach the sermon at the morning service.

Educated in England at London University, Jews' College, and Yeshiva Etz Chaim, Dr. Jakobovits served as rabbi of the Great Synagogue, London, to which position he succeeded on the death of his father, the late Rabbi Dr. Julius Jakobovits, Dayan (Judge) at the Jewish Ecclesiastical Court of the

British Commonwealth.

In 1948, the year Ireland and Israel were declared republics, Rabbi Jakobovits was called to his present position in Ireland, in succession to Dr. Isaac Herzog, the present Chief Rabbi of Israel.

Dr. Jakobovits has travelled extensively throughout Europe and Israel, and has on several occasions been honored by the Irish Government for
