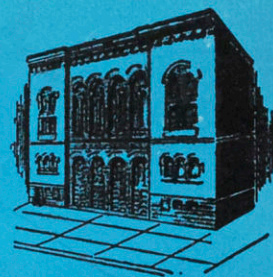

No chometz may be eaten after 9:30 A.M. this Friday, April 4th. All chometz should be completely disposed of by 10:30 Friday morning.
