THE NEW MONTH

This coming Sabbath, August 16th, will mark the beginning of the new month of Elul. Special services for the beginning of this month will be recited in our synagogue on Saturday and Sunday mornings.

Elul is the final month of the Jewish year which begins on Rosh Hashanah. As such it marks the conclusion of one more chapter in our spiritual lives. In accordance with our tradition this month serves as a preparation for the High Holy Day season. If the mood of Adar is gaiety, and that of Av, sadness and mourning; the spirit of Elul is one of Teshuvah — penitence. During this month, we systematically search our lives for possible deficiencies in our relationship to G-d and to fellow man. The tone for this period is set by the Shofar which is sounded at every service throughout the month.

Why not usher in this prelude to the penitential season by attending the special Rosh Chodesh prayers in our Synagogue this Sabbath? The service will begin as usual at 9:00 A.M. and will conclude before 12:00.
