### Honors and Awards

Continuing in the exemplary tradition of previous graduating classes, the senior class of 1969 has established for itself an enviable record in many facets of academic competition. Of fifty-five students who were eligible to take the New York State Regents Scholarship Examination, twenty-six were winners, while nine will receive State Scholarships as alternates. Once again, the percentage of winners and alternates tops all Day Schools in the State and constitutes one of the highest records of any school in New York.

In the National Merit Award Competition, Ramaz placed two finalists and two semi-finalists while thirteen students received letters of commendation. Perhaps the crowning achievement was the winning of two Westinghouse Awards in Science and Mathematics by seniors in this graduating class.

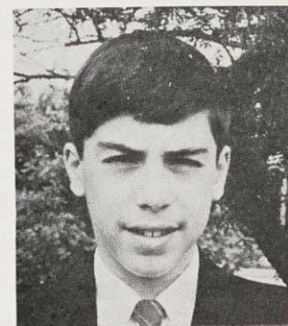
