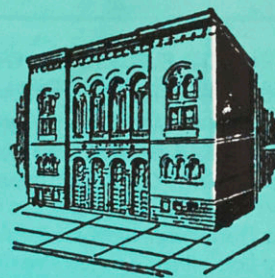

RAMAZ GRADUATES CLASS WITH RECORD HONORS

The class of 1971 of Ramaz High School will be graduated at special commencement exercises to be held on Thursday evening, June 17th. The class will go into the record as one of the most outstanding in the history of the school.

Numbering fifty-six students, the class has five children of members of the congregation as well as a number of other students who are close to our Kehilath Jeshurun family.

National Merit Awards

This class broke just about every record in National Merit Competition. It placed seven finalists in this competition — one in the class was a National Merit Scholar. In addition, eleven of the students won Letters of Commendation. The total thus honored was eighteen out of a possible fifty-six, a percentage that we have reason to believe is unequalled anywhere in the country.

In competition for Regents Scholarships in New York State, the students also did remarkably well. There were thirty-two winners and six alternates out of fifty-two students who were eligible to take the exam. Again, a record of which the school can be justifiably proud.

The class has stood out in other ways which are perhaps less pretentious, but no less important. It pioneered in the establishment of a daily minyan in the school and led in participation in that minyan. It also started the first co-op store in the history of Ramaz. Like its predecessor, the class of 1970, it embarked on a work study program during April and May which found its members engaged in educationally worthwhile work in such varied institutions as the Headstart Program, the

KEHILATH JESHURUN FOR SOVIET JEWRY FOUNDED

**Harry Green and Gil Kahn
Serve As Co-Chairmen**

A new affiliate of the congregation has made its appearance during the past week. A letter was sent out to the entire Kehilath Jeshurun family — members and non-members — announcing the formation of Kehilath Jeshurun for Soviet Jewry, an organization designed to stimulate activity and interest in behalf of Soviet Jewry among the members of this community.

K.J.S.J. as presently constituted, contemplates a threefold program for Soviet Jewry:

1. The dissemination of information and news about the plight of Soviet Jewry and about programs designed to alleviate that plight.

2. The formation of an extensive membership in the organization with a nominal contribution per member of not more than \$10.00. The purpose is to encourage every Jewish man, woman and child to identify himself in a formal way with the efforts which are being carried on in behalf of Soviet Jewry.

3. The enlistment of a Board of Directors of between thirty and forty people who will oversee the organization, who will decide on the disbursement of the funds raised through membership dues and who will serve as contacts with the members of the congregation to alert them quickly in the event that a rally or protest meeting is being planned.
