SALE OF CHAMETZ

In advance of the Passover Festival, every Jew who owns Chametz is required to dispose of it. Most of us cannot dispose of all the Chametz in our possession except by selling it. Jewish law provides that an agent may be authorized to sell one's Chametz. The agent may be appointed in person by speaking to either of the rabbis or to Mr. Rosenberg. The form which is found in this Bulletin can also be used for this purpose. Please fill it out and return it to the synagogue office without delay.
